

Centennial High School Athletics
Social Media and Behavior Contract
2026-2027 Season

Participation in interscholastic athletics at Centennial High School is a privilege. Student athletes are expected to adhere to a high standard of self and school representation. All student athletes are ambassadors of Centennial and carry with them the responsibility of presenting themselves in a responsible and in a positive manner. This includes all school and athletic related events as well as personal conduct on any social media forum. Therefore, all students wishing to take advantage of the opportunities presented to them by Centennial High School must show a commitment to their athletic program by adhering to the "Social Media/Behavior Rule" that will be in effect for the 2026-2027 season. All student athletes will be expected to follow these social media guidelines:

- 1) Any student athlete who chooses to post or repost inappropriate or distasteful images or comments on any type of social media forum will be removed from their team. This includes any form of illegal behavior and additional consequences can occur depending on the situation. Please keep in mind when posting pictures on Social Media in uniform, can only be at a game, comp, PR Event, etc. Cannot be a random post. I will also **NOT** use my uniform as a halloween costume, including parents.
- 2) Any student athlete and/or parent who chooses to post derogatory comments or images towards their team, teammates, Centennial High School or its teachers, staff or administration will be removed from their team. Talking bad about coaches will also result in removal from the team. You are entitled to your opinion but please keep in mind others around you when speaking.
- 3) Any form of bullying or posing about another team member can result in removal from the squad, benched from a game, and can result in additional consequences.
- 4) Any athlete or parent who displays unprofessional, disrespectful, or unsportsmanlike behavior toward the Spiritline program, coaching staff, teammates, school officials, or the school community—whether in person, online, or through any form of communication—will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including immediate removal from the team.

The **Centennial coaches and administrators will have the final decision** regarding what is deemed inappropriate in regards to social media, all student athletes are expected to follow the "Social Media and Behavior Rule" from the time they are selected until their season ends. All decisions made by the Centennial coaches and/or administration are final.
